Syllogism— (form of deductive reasoning)

- 1.) Major Premise: No reptiles have fur
- 2.) Minor Premise: All snakes are reptiles
- 3.) Conclusion: No snakes have fur

“The Christian’s Speech”

Syllogism—Biblical View of the Mouth

1.) *Major Premise:*

God’s mouth is a source of blessing.

2.) *Minor Premise:*

Man is made in the image of God.

3.) *Conclusion:*

Man’s mouth is a source of blessing.
