Christological Highlights—

Zech. 9:9 "... behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass."

Zech. 9:16 "And the LORD their God shall save them in that day as the flock of his people"

Zech. 10:3 "Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds ... for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah"

Zech. 11:12-13 "So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver ... And I took the thirty pieces of silver, and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD."

Christological Highlights—
