## **Repentance:**

- Directed toward the sinning self.
- It is honest self-awareness.

## **Belief:**

- Directed toward the saving God.
- It is receiving/accepting the truth.

# Doctrine of Salvation—“Church of Christ”

*Their 5 steps of salvation:*

*Early, Campbellites:*

- 1.) Believe the Gospel
- 2.) Repent of Sin
- 3.) Be Baptized
- 4.) Have Sin Remitted
- 5.) Receive the Spirit

*Today:*

- 1.) Hear the Gospel
- 2.) Believe the Gospel
- 3.) Repent of Sins
- 4.) Confess Christ
- 5.) Be Baptized (*wash away sin*)

Acts 2:38 & 22:13: Biblically, fitness for baptism is established on the forgiveness of sin, *not vice-versa*. **Forgiveness of sin** has strong links to a salvation that is through faith, in Jesus:

- *Luke 24:47 (repentance)*
- *Acts 3:19 (repentance)*
- *Acts 5:31 (repentance)*
- *Acts 10:43 (belief)*
- *Acts 13:38 (belief)*
- *Acts 26:18 (faith)*
- *Ephesians 1:7 (faith)*
- *Colossians 1:14 (faith) (cf. Rom. 10:13, 3:25)*
