- It is honest self-awareness.

Belief:

Directed toward the sinning self.

Directed toward the saving God. • It is <u>receiving/accepting</u> the truth.

Doctrine of Salvation—"Church of Christ"

Their 5 steps of salvation:

Early, Campbellites:

- 1.) Believe the Gospel
- 2.) <u>Repent</u> of Sin
- 3.) Be <u>Baptized</u>
- 4.) Have Sin Remitted
- 5.) Receive the Spirit

<u>Today</u>:

- 1.) Hear the Gospel
- 2.) Believe the Gospel
- 3.) <u>Repent</u> of Sins
- 4.) Confess Christ
- 5.) Be <u>Baptized</u> (wash away sin)

Acts 2:38 & 22:13: Biblically, fitness for <u>baptism</u> is established on the *forgiveness of sin*, not vice-versa. Forgiveness of sin has strong links to a salvation that is through faith, in Jesus:
