<u>John 1.7</u> The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might <u>believe</u>.

John 1.12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

<u>John 1.50</u> Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, <u>believest</u> thou? thou shalt see greater things than these.

John 2.11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

<u>John 2.22</u> When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they <u>believed</u> the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

<u>John 2.23</u> Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast day, many <u>believed</u> in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.

John 3.12 If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you of heavenly things?

<u>John 3.18</u> He that <u>believeth</u> on him is not condemned: but he that <u>believeth</u> not is condemned already, because he hath not <u>believed</u> in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

<u>John 4.39</u> And many of the Samaritans of that city <u>believed</u> on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did.

<u>John 4.41</u> And many more <u>believed</u> because of his own word; <u>42</u> And said unto the woman, Now we <u>believe</u>, not because of thy saying: for we have heard him ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.

<u>John 4.48</u> Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

<u>John 4.50</u> Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man <u>believed</u> the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.

<u>John 4.53</u> So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself <u>believed</u>, and his whole house.

<u>John 5.38</u> And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye <u>believe</u> not.

<u>John 5.44</u> How can ye <u>believe</u>, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only?

<u>John 5.46</u> For had ye believed Moses, ye would have <u>believed</u> me: for he wrote of me. <u>47</u> But if ye <u>believe</u> not his writings, how shall ye <u>believe</u> my words?

<u>John 6.29</u> Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye <u>believe</u> on him whom he hath sent. <u>30</u> They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and <u>believe</u> thee? what dost thou work?

John 6.36 But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.

<u>John 6.64</u> But there are some of you that <u>believe</u> not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that <u>believed</u> not, and who should betray him.

John 6.69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.
