Alexandrian Text Family:

- Represents the <u>oldest</u> of extant, NT Greek manuscripts. Tends to be more choppy in its rendering, and contains many, shorter verse renderings.
- The Alexandrian textual family is considered by many to be the most faithful in preserving the original text of the New Testament. Both Codex Sinaiticus and Codex Vaticanus, along with some significant papyri, contain this text type.

Byzantine Text Family:

- Greek manuscripts. Tends to read more
- The form of text which is known to have the fifteenth century.

Represents the large majority of extant, NT smoothly, and contains many longer verses.

• Ensemble Text: Accumulated to represent an empirical, majority reading of extant manuscripts.

• Eclectic Text: Reconstructed to achieve an scholarly approximation of the original manuscripts.

Accusations

Alexandrian-Based, Critical Greek NT:

 In the critical editions of Westcott and Hort, Tischendorf and Nestle-Aland, the <u>Byzantine</u> <u>tradition is entirely abandoned</u> and the text is based almost entirely on the two oldest manuscripts, Codex Vaticanus Graecus 1209 and Codex Sinaiticus. Where these two manuscripts differ, Westcott and Hort usually follow Vaticanus.
