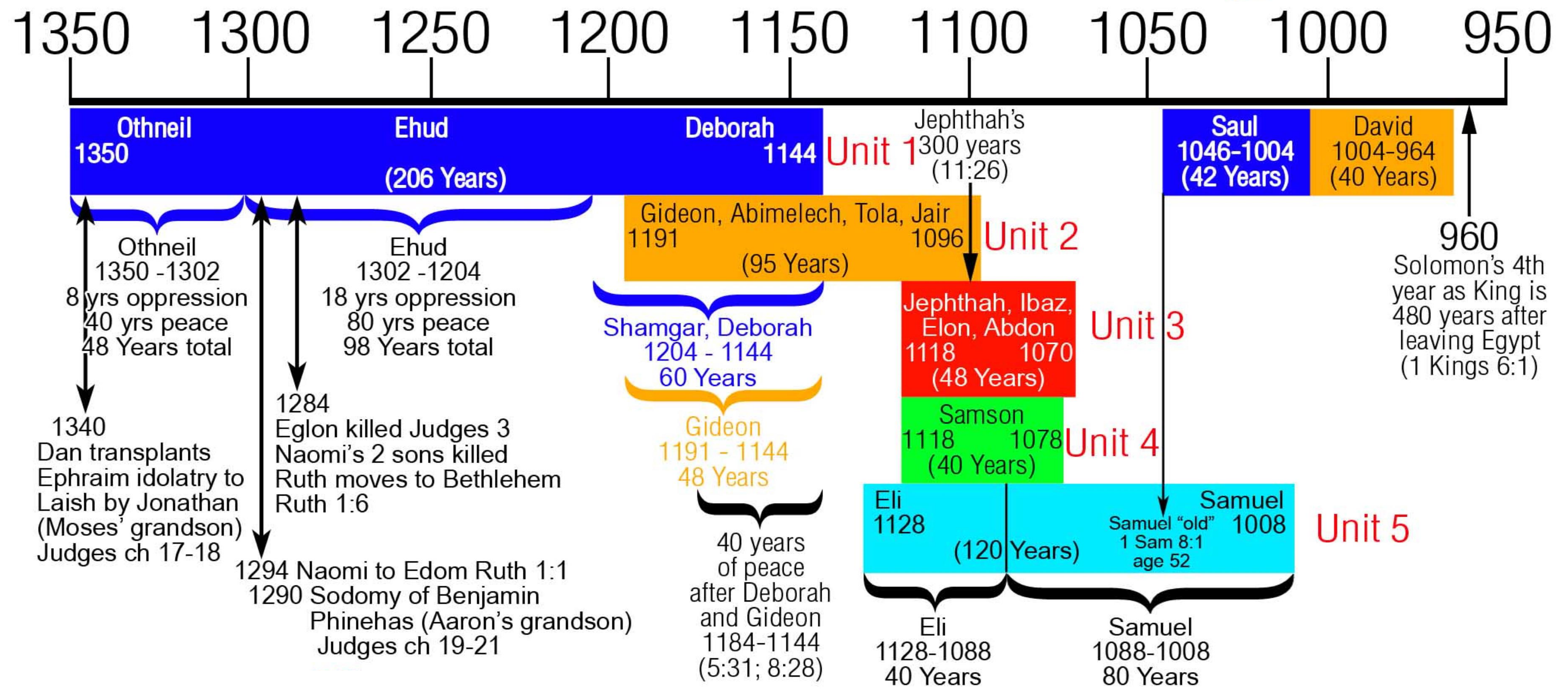

Chapter 1:

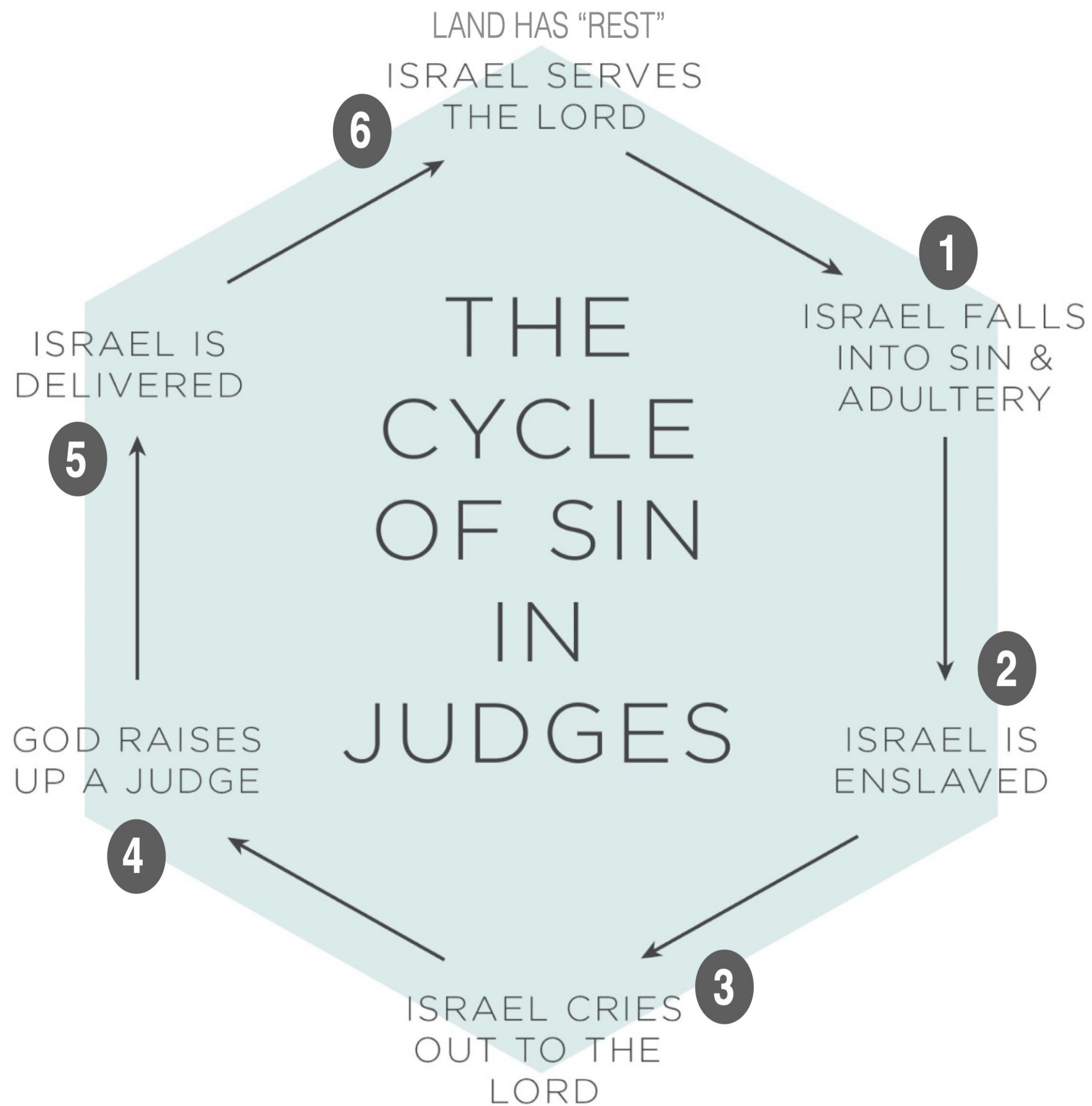
Provides the “why” Israel did not complete the task of taking the land.

3.) Repentance, **2:15b, 18c**; 3:9a

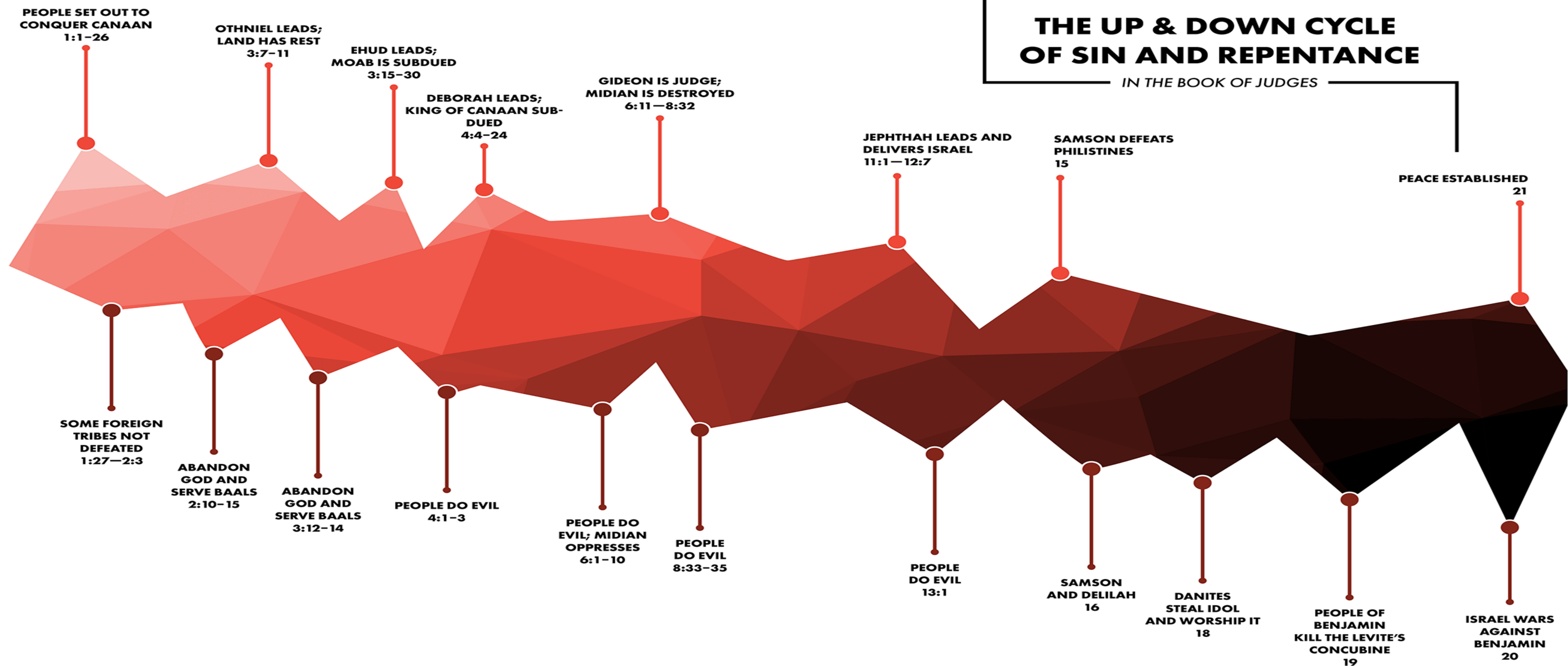
4.) Raising, **2:16, 18a**; 3:9b-10a

6.) Rest, **2:11-13**; 3:11

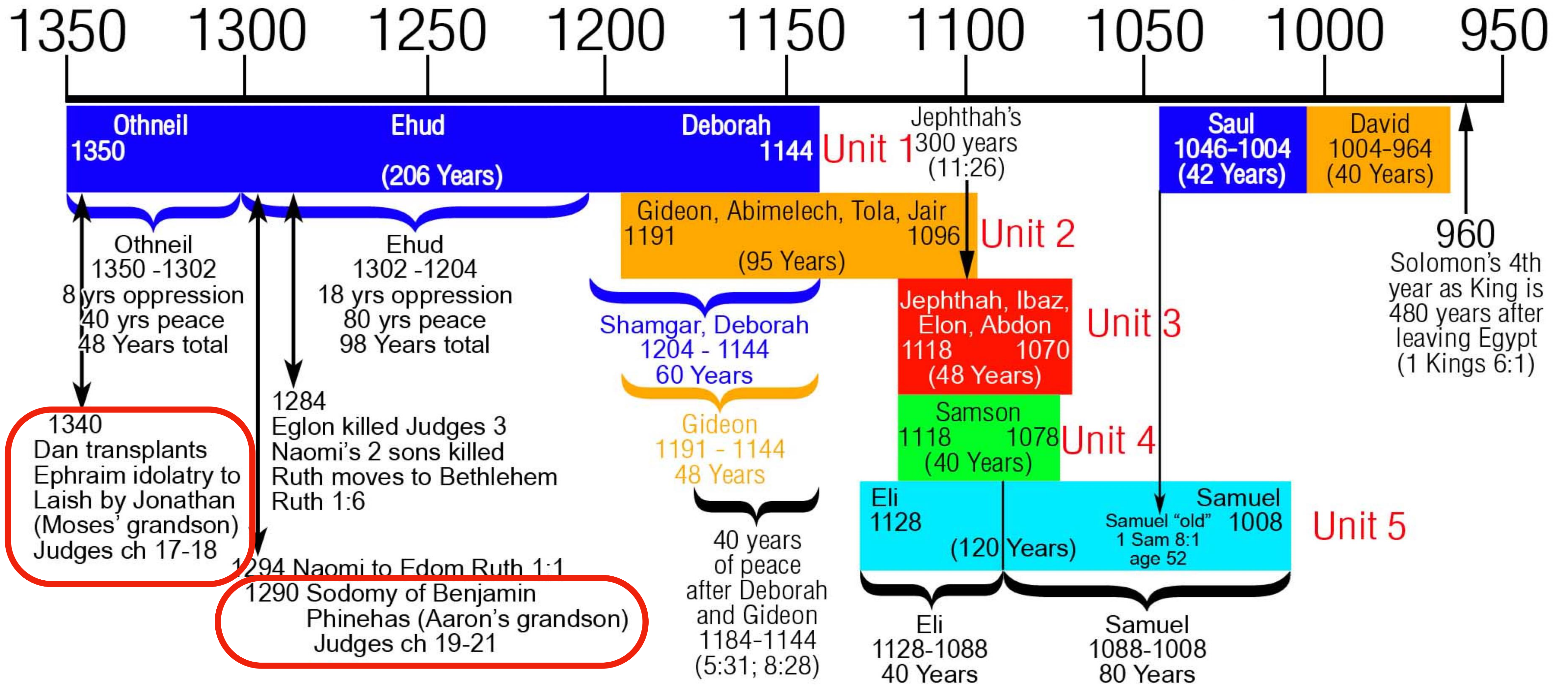

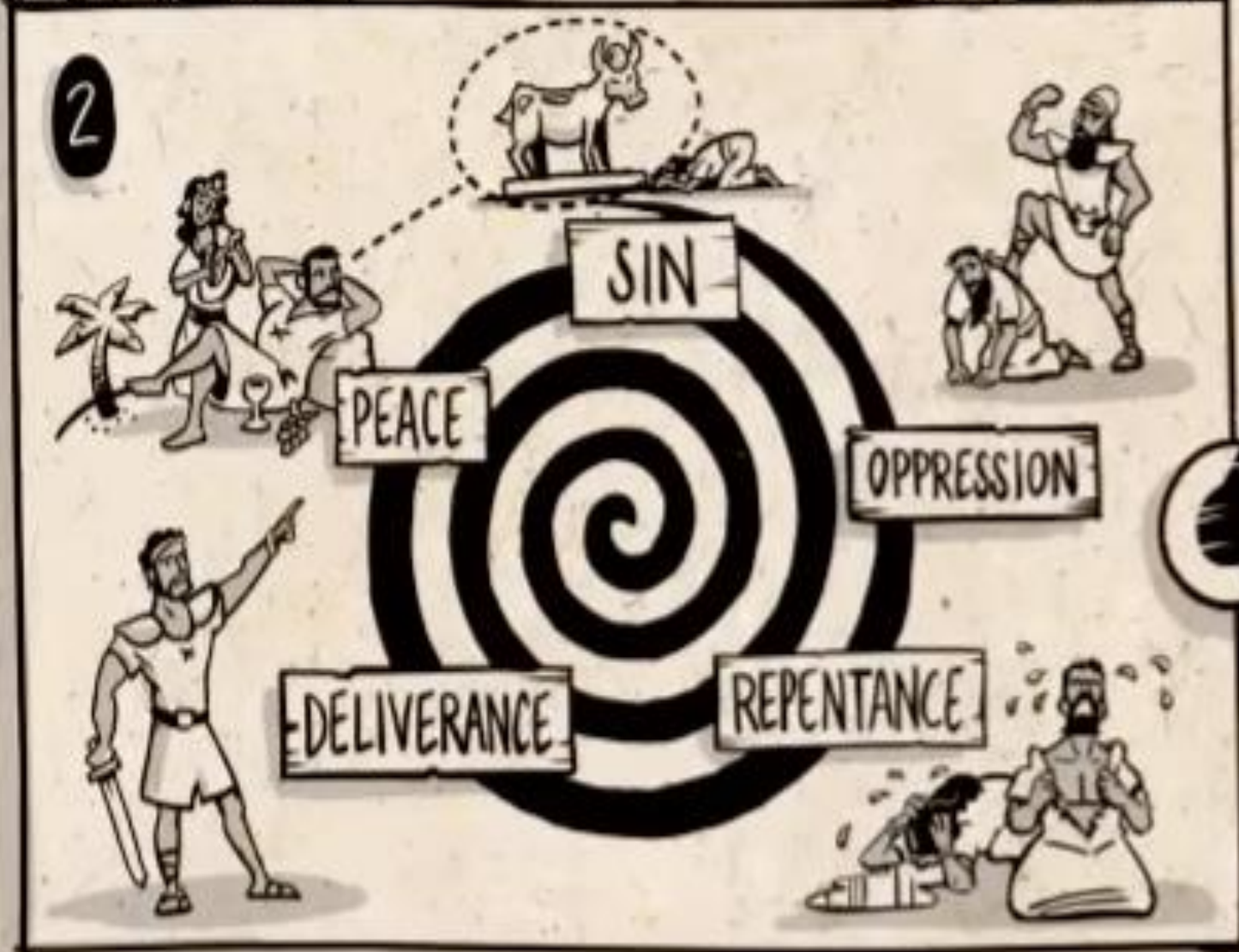
